Dear Sir,

This letter confirms our understanding that NP Engineers and Conductors at Cranbrook will be entitled to book a short trip following TCS service regardless of the miles earned on such tour of duty subject to the following conditions;

1. It will be the responsibility of the employee to book a short trip immediately upon completion of the qualifying TCS tour of duty and must book a minimum of 8 hours rest.
2. The second no short provided by local rules do not apply to this TCS short trip rule.
3. An employee will not be entitled to book a second short trip if the next tour of duty is a TCS tour or other short trip of 150 miles or less.
4. This TCS short trip rule does not apply to spare employees called for a TCS tour of duty.

This understanding will not result in any added expense to the Company in the application or administration nor will it cause any delays to trains or traffic.

This provision is entered into without precedent or prejudice to the positions of either party.

This provision can be amended, revised or cancelled upon seven days written notice by either party.

The Parties agree this understanding is effective on Friday May 24, 2008 at 0001 including employees called for TCS prior to but reporting off duty subsequent to the effective time of this understanding.
